STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter One Hundred Sixty-Seven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-Five Relative to Limitation of Actions for Injuries Caused by Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter one hundred sixty-seven of the public laws of 2 nineteen hundred twenty-five is hereby amended by adding 3 after the word "trailers" in the fourth line of section eleven 4 of said chapter the words 'subject to the supervision and 5 control of the public utilities commission,' so that said sec- 6 tion eleven as amended shall read as follows:

Sect. 11. *Limitation of Action.* Actions of tort for in-

2 juries to the person or for death and for injuries to or
3 destruction of property caused by the ownership, operation,
4 maintenance or use on the ways of the state of motor vehi-
5 cles or trailers subject to the supervision and control of the
6 public utilities commission shall be commenced only within
7 one year next after the cause of action occurs.'
