IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Collateral Loans by Mutual Savings

Banks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-seven, sub-division twelve, of chapter one

- 2 hundred forty-four, of the public laws of nineteen hundred
- 3 and twenty-three, is hereby amended by striking out all of
- 4 paragraphs "c" and "d" and inserting therein the following
- 5 paragraph to be lettered "c":
 - 'c. In notes with a pledge as collateral of such funds,
- 2 bonds, notes, or stocks, as in the judgment of the trustees,
- 3 it is safe and for the interests of the bank to accept to an
- 4 amount not exceeding eighty per cent of the market value
- 5 of such funds, bonds, notes or stocks.'
