STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Requiring Teachers to File a Health Certificate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall enter upon the duties of a
2 teacher in any public school unless and until he shall have
3 filed a certificate from a licensed and practicing physician
4 of this state certifying that such person is free from all
5 infectious and communicable diseases.

Sect. 2. A similar certificate shall be filed by such teacher
2 at the commencement of each school year thereafter, if he
3 then continues as teacher; or if not so continuing, then
4 immediately prior to a subsequent entering upon the duties
5 of a teacher.

Sect. 3. Such certificate shall be filed with the superin-
2 tending school committee and there kept as a public record
3 and shall be available to inspection at all reasonable times.

Sect. 4. If such teacher fails to file such certificate, as
2 aforesaid, or files one which is false, the salary or com-
3 pensation which he would receive shall not be paid for the
4 period of such failure.

Sect. 5. All acts, parts of acts, inconsistent herewith are
2 hereby repealed.
