STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Appropriation for the Abolishment of Grade Crossings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section thirty-seven of chapter twenty-four of the revised
2 statutes as amended by chapter fifty-two of the public laws
3 of nineteen hundred twenty-one, is hereby further amended
4 by striking out the word "ten" in the third and fifth lines
5 of said amended section, and substituting therefor the word
6 'fifteen,' so that said section as further amended shall read
7 as follows:

'Sect. 37. Appropriation increased from Ten Thousand 2 Dollars to Fifteen Thousand Dollars. The amount to be

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3 paid under the provisions of the three preceding sections 4 by the state in any one year, except as herein provided, 5 shall not exceed fifteen thousand dollars, and said sum shall 6 be annually appropriated. The amounts to be appropriated 7 under the provisions of this section shall be cumulative and 8 any part of said sum of fifteen thousand dollars not ex-9 pended during the year for which it is appropriated shall, 10 at the close of said year, be added to the sums subsequently 11 appropriated, and may be expended in any subsequent year 12 or years.'
