STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Increase the Amount to be Paid for Clerk Hire in the Office of the Clerk of Courts in the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen 2 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further 3 amended by striking out the words "fifty-one hundred and

4 twenty-four" in the fourth line of paragraph four of said

5 section, and inserting in place thereof the words 'sixty-one

6 hundred and twenty-four,' so that paragraph four, as

7 amended, in so far as it relates to the annual amount to be

8 paid for clerk hire in the office of the clerk of courts in 9 Cumberland county, shall read as follows:

'Allowance for clerk hire in office of clerk of courts, Cum-2 berland county, increase. For clerks in the office of clerk 3 of courts, sixty-one hundred and twenty-four dollars.'
