#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Lobster Industry Within Two Miles of the Shore of Monhegan Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section one of chapter sixty-one of the private and special 2 laws of nineteen hundred and seven, as amended by sec-

- 3 tion one of chapter two hundred ten of the private and
- 4 special laws of nineteen hundred and nine, as amended by
- 5 chapter fifty-eight of the private and special laws of nine-
- 6 teen hundred twenty-one, is hereby further amended by
- 7 striking out the whole of said section and inserting in place

8 thereof the following: 'It shall be unlawful to take, catch, 9 kill, destroy or set any lobster trap or other device for the 10 purpose of taking, catching, killing or destroying any lob11 ster or lobsters within two miles of the shore of Monhegan
12 Island between the twenty-fifth day of June of each year
13 and the first day of December following,' so that said sec14 tion, as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. It shall be unlawful to take, catch, kill, destroy 2 or set any lobster trap or other device for the purpose of 3 taking, catching, killing or destroying any lobster or lob-4 sters within two miles of the shore of Monhegan Island be-5 tween the twenty-fifth day of June of each year and the first 6 day of December following.'
