STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Equal School Privileges for all Pupils.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section twenty of chapter sixteen of the revised 2 statutes for nineteen hundred sixteen be amended by strik-3 ing out in line five after the word "than" the word "thirty" 4 and insert in place thereof the words 'thirty-two' so that 5 the section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 20. The school moneys of every town shall be so 2 expended as to give as nearly as practicable the same aggre-3 gate annual length of terms in all its schools, and every 4 town shall make provision for the maintenance of its 5 schools for not less than thirty-two weeks annually. Any

6 town failing to maintain its schools as provided in this sec-7 tion, shall be debarred from drawing its state school moneys 8 until it shall have made suitable provision for so maintain-9 ing them thereafter.'
