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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT Relating to the Superintendent of Schools in  
Harpwell.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph two of section fifty-five of chapter sixteen of  
2 the revised statutes as amended, is hereby further amended  
3 by adding at the end thereof the following: 'but the super-  
4 intending school committee of the town of Harpswell shall  
5 elect its own superintendent and the state shall pay thereto  
6 a sum equal to that paid by said town for said superintend-  
7 ence but not exceeding one thousand dollars,' so that said  
8 paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'Paragraph 2. Any school supervisory union formed under the provisions of this section shall include not less than thirty nor more than fifty schools unless the state superintendent of public schools shall find upon representation of any school committee that owing to geographical situation or other reasons it is to the advantage of the state and of said towns that a union shall include fewer than thirty or more than fifty schools, but the superintending school committee of the town of Harpswell shall elect its own superintendent and the state shall pay thereto a sum equal to that paid by said town for said superintendence but not exceeding one thousand dollars.'
