STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Increase the Amount to Be Paid for Clerk Hire in the Office of the Register of Deeds in the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 117, sec. 45; P. L., 1925, c. 49; relating to clerk hire in county offices, amended. Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter forty-nine of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-five, is hereby amended by striking out the words, "forty-eight hundred and fifty-two dollars; deputy register of deeds, eleven hundred and forty-

8 four dollars," in the second and third lines of paragraph two
9 of said section, and inserting in place thereof the words
10 'fifty-five hundred and seventy-six dollars; deputy register
11 of deeds, thirteen hundred dollars,' so that paragraph two,
12 as amended, insofar as it relates to the annual amount to
13 be paid for clerk hire in the office of the register of deeds
14 in Cumberland county, shall read as follows:

'Clerk hire in office of register of deeds, Cumberland
2 county, increased. For clerks in the office of register of
3 deeds, fifty-five hundred and seventy-six dollars; deputy
4 register of deeds, thirteen hundred dollars.'
