STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Anna L. Gagan, Providing a State Pension.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to 2 be paid to Anna L. Gagan of Lewiston a pension of fifteen 3 dollars per month instead of the amount now received, be-4 ginning January first, nineteen hundred twenty-nine, and 5 continuing the remainder of her life.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

She is a Spanish war widow and has been for nineteen years. She has a son away and has not heard from him for two years. She has one daughter living with her now whose health is poor. She is nineteen years old and unable to work. Thirty dollars per month is the amount now received by the widow from the Federal Government Widows' Pension. Her rent alone is twenty dollars per month, and her health is getting worse.
