# STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Punish Derogatory Statements Affecting Banks or Trust Companies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Any person who shall wilfully and maliciously make, cir-2 culate or transmit to another or others, any statement, rumor 3 or suggestion, written, printed or by word of mouth, which 4 is directly or by inference derogatory to the financial con-5 dition or affects the solvency or financial standing of any 6 bank, savings bank, banking institution or trust company 7 doing business in this state, or who shall counsel, aid, pro-8 cure or induce another to start, transmit or circulate any 9 such statement or rumor, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor,

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10 and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of 11 not more than one thousand dollars or by imprisonment for 12 a term of not more than one year, or both.

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
