STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to Recording Certificate of Decree Barring Husband or Wife of Rights in Real Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section sixteen of chapter sixty-six of the revised statutes 2 is hereby amended by striking out the words "in the same 3 county" in the fifth line of said section, and by inserting 4 in place thereof the words 'in any county where real estate 5 which may be affected by such decree is situated,' so that 6 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 16. Certified copies of decree to be filed in offices 2 of registers of deeds and recorded. Whenever any decree 3 provided for in sections ten and eleven hereof shall become

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4 effective either by reason of expiration of the time within 5 which an appeal might have been taken or if final judg-6 ment on appeal, the register of probate, shall forthwith file 7 in the office of the register of deeds in the county or coun-8 ties where real estate which may be affected by such decree 9 is situated, under seal of the probate court, a certified copy 10 thereof which the register of deeds shall record without 11 fee.'
