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AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty of Chapter Four of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Appointment of Deputy Town Clerks.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty of chapter four of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words "woman, otherwise qualified by the constitution." in the first and second lines of the last paragraph of said section, and by inserting in place thereof the words 'citizen thereof,' so that said last paragraph of said section shall read as follows:

'The clerk may also appoint a citizen thereof, who in his

2 absence may so far act as deputy clerk as to receive and  
3 record chattel mortgages and other papers, and make certi-  
4 fied copies of the records in the clerk's office.'
