IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend the Certificate of Organization of the Damariscotta-Newcastle Water Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The certificate of organization of the Dama-

- 2 riscotta-Newcastle Water Company is hereby amended by
- 3 adding to its statement of corporate purposes the follow-
- 4 ing, to wit: to purchase, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mort-
- 5 gage, pledge or otherwise dispose of the shares of the cap-
- 6 ital stock of, or any bonds, securities or evidences of in-
- 7 debtedness created by any other corporation or corporations
- 8 of this or any other state, territory or country and while
- 9 the owner of such stock, bonds, securities or evidences of

10 indebtedness to exercise all the rights, powers, privileges
11 of ownership, including the right to vote thereon; also to
12 build, create, develop, purchase, procure, hold, operate, sell,
13 assign, mortgage or otherwise dispose of plants and proper14 ties for supplying water for all purposes, water works, plants
15 and systems and any real or personal property used or
16 useful in connection therewith.

Sect. 2. Nothing herein is intended to repeal or shall be 2 construed as repealing the whole or any part of any exist-3 ing statute. And all the rights and duties herein mentioned 4 shall be exercised and performed in accordance with all the 5 applicable provisions of chapter fifty-five of the revised 6 statutes.
