STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Two of Chapter One Hundred
Seventy-three of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen
Hundred and Five Relating to the Purposes of the Milo
Water Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter one hundred seventy-three of the
2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and five is
3 hereby amended so that said section as amended shall read
4 as follows:

'Sect. 2. The purposes of said corporation shall be to
2 purchase, hold, sell, assign, procure, pledge or otherwise
3 dispose of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds,

4 securities or evidences of indebtedness created by any other
5 corporation or corporations of this or any other state, terri-
6 tory or country, and while the owner of said stock, bonds,
7 securities or evidences of indebtedness to exercise all the
8 rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the
9 right to vote thereon; also to supply water for public and
10 private use and for any and all purposes in the towns of
11 Milo and Brownville, Piscataquis county, and to construct,
12 maintain and operate a system of sewers and drainage in
13 and for said towns of Milo and Brownville. Nothing here-
14 in is intended to repeal or shall be construed as repealing the
15 whole or any part of any existing statute. And all the rights
16 and duties herein mentioned shall be exercised and per-
17 formed in accordance with all the applicable provisions of
18 chapter fifty-five of the revised statutes.'
