STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to More Fully Perfect the Records of the Adjutant General's Office, and to Encourage the Writing of Histories of Maine Soldiers in the Spanish War and World War.

Resolved: That the adjutant general, under the direction 2 of the governor and council, be authorized to collect diaries 3 or copies of them, letters, personal accounts and incidents 4 of the battle field, camp and hospital, or any other interest-5 ing and valuable material for army history, and to arrange 6 and index all such matter and data under the branch of 7 service to which it may appertain, and that such sum be 8 paid as the governor and council may deem necessary.
