RESOLVE, in Favor of the State Board of Mothers' Aid.

EMERGENCY PREAMBLE

Whereas, the funds appropriated by the legislature for carrying on the work of the state board of mothers' aid are insufficient to continue the present number of active cases for the remaining months of the fiscal year to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine; and

Whereas, the state board of mothers' aid, in an endeavor to care for as many mothers with dependent children as the appropriation would permit, has carried an excess liability on the annual appropriation, which means that it will be necessary

to suspend all active cases for a period of five weeks in order to live within the appropriation available; and

Whereas, the aforesaid facts seem to this legislature to constitute an emergency to protect the welfare of the recipients to mothers' aid; now, therefore, be it

Resolved: That there be appropriated to pay prospective obligations of the state to accrue in carrying on the activities of the state board of mothers' aid nine thousand five hundred and seventy dollars.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
