STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fishing in Kewayden Lake in the Town
of Stoneham.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any fish except salmon and trout through the ice in
3 Kewayden lake in the town of Stoneham.

Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any fish at any time in all the tributaries of Kewayden
3 lake in said town of Stoneham.

Sect. 3. All acts, parts of acts, inconsistent herewith are
2 hereby repealed.
