STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Protection of Fur-Bearing Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The last paragraph of section forty-six of
2 chapter two hundred nineteen of the public laws of nine-
3 teen hundred seventeen, as amended, is hereby further
4 amended by striking out the whole of said paragraph and
5 inserting in place thereof the following:

‘Provided, however, that it shall be lawful to hunt, catch,
2 pursue or kill skunks at night from the fifteenth day of
3 October to the last day of the following February, both
4 days inclusive, and that it shall be lawful to hunt, catch,
5 pursue or kill raccoons at night from the first day of Octo-

ber to the last day of the following February, both days
inclusive.'

Sect. 2. All acts, parts of acts, inconsistent herewith are
hereby repealed.
