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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT Relating to Deportation of Alien Criminals, Paupers  
and Insane.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The county attorney in his county, (1) in case of the con-  
2 viction of any alien before the supreme judicial court or  
3 before any superior court of any felony,

The municipal officers of their municipalities, (2) in case  
2 an alien becomes a pauper and is committed to any poor  
3 house,

And the hospital trustees, (3) in case an alien is or be-  
2 comes insane or feeble minded so that he is committed to

3 one of the insane hospitals or to the Maine school for feeble  
4 minded, shall make or cause to be made an investigation  
5 of the past history of such alien and shall cause the result  
6 thereof, together with his or their recommendations as to  
7 the deportation of such alien to be forwarded to the United  
8 States immigration authorities having such matters in  
9 charge.
