## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty-Five of Chapter Eighty-Seven of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Change of Venue in the Supreme Judicial Court and Superior Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
R. S. c. 87, section 85; relating to change of venue. Sec2 tion twenty-five of chapter eighty-seven of revised statutes
3 is hereby amended by inserting the words 'or of the superior
4 court' after the word "court" in the second line of said sec5 tion, so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 25. Superior court judges given power to change 2 venue. Any judge of the supreme judicial court, or of 3 the superior court, while holding a nisi prius term, on mo4 tion of either party, shall, for cause shown, order the trans-5 fer of any civil action, or criminal case, pending in said 6 court, to the docket thereof in any other county for trial, 7 preserving all attachments.'

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
