STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Establishment of Residence for Certain Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Husband and wife may each have a separate residence for 2 purposes of voting, office holding, serving on jury or taxa-3 tion.
