AN ACT Providing for the Fencing and Care of Burying Grounds in Unincorporated Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: The county commissioners of any county in which is an
2 unincorporated place or places wherein are any ancient or
3 public burying grounds, shall cause the same to be suitably
4 fenced and thereafter maintained; they also shall cause the
5 burying grounds aforesaid to be kept in proper condition
6 and any bushes therein to be cut.
