STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Four of Chapter Two Hundred Eleven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-One, Relating to Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter two hundred eleven, section four, relating to stationary vehicles, amended. Section four of chapter two hundred eleven of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, as amended by public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-three, nineteen hundred and twenty-five and nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, is hereby amended by adding to said section the following: 'No person shall leave his vehicle or animal drawn team stationary on a hill or

9 on a curve or on any way in such place and in such man-
10 ner as to obscure the view of operators of other vehicles or
11 drivers of other animal drawn teams,' so that the section,
12 as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. *Stationary vehicles shall not obscure view.* No
2 person shall leave his vehicle stationary on a way so as to
3 obstruct the free passage of other vehicles; or allow an
4 animal drawn team to be in the way unattended unless it is
5 reasonably fastened. No person shall leave his vehicle or
6 animal drawn team stationary on a hill or on a curve or
7 on any way in such place and in such manner as to obscure
8 the view of operators of other vehicles or drivers of other
9 animal drawn teams.'
