STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section One of Chapter Two Hundred and Thirty-One of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nine Relating to the Aroostook Mutual Fire Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section one of chapter two hundred and thirty-one of the 2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and nine is 3 hereby amended by substituting in place of the words "in 4 the county of Aroostook" in the ninth line thereof the 5 words 'within the state of Maine,' so that said section as 6 amended shall read as follows:

Pitcher, with all other members that may hereafter 5 be admitted to the company, are hereby made a corpora-6 tion under the name of the Aroostook Mutual Fire Insur-7 ance Company, for the purpose only of carrying on busi-8 ness as a mutual fire insurance company for insurance upon 9 potatoes, local or in transit, and upon potato-houses and 10 other real and personal property within the state of Maine, 11 with all the powers, rights and privileges, and subject to 12 all the duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth in all the 13 general laws of the state relating to such insurance com-14 panies, except as herein provided.'
