HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide a Bounty on Seals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

A bounty of two dollars for each and every seal killed in
2 the waters of this state shall be paid by the treasurer of the
3 town in which such seal is killed, to the person exhibiting
4 to said treasurer the whole head of such seal within thirty
5 days after said seal was killed. Such treasurer shall destroy
6 it, and shall then proceed as in chapter two hundred forty-
7 nine of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-seven.
8 The certificates shall be in substantially the same form as
9 provided under said chapter two hundred forty-nine of the
10 public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-seven, with such
11 changes therein as may be necessary to comply with this
12 act.
