# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Maine State Prison for Maintenance and Current Expenses.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for 2 the Maine state prison for the fiscal year from July first, 3 nineteen hundred twenty-nine, to June thirtieth, nineteen 4 hundred thirty, the sum of one hundred ten thousand six 5 hundred fifty dollars and ninety-two cents for the purposes 6 hereinafter specified, namely:

July 1, 1929—June 30, 1930

Personal services of officers and employees, fifty-five thousand six hundred fifty dollars and ninety-

two cents ...... \$55,650.92

Maintenance, including food supplies, clothing, re-
pairs and equipment, and general expenses, fifty
thousand dollars
Retiring and pensioning prison officials, two thou-
sand five hundred dollars
Permanent improvement, two thousand five hun-
