STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall sell any liquid or substance containing
2 more than one-half of one per cent of alcohol with a
3 knowledge of having reasonable cause to believe that the
4 same is to be used as beverage. Any person violating the
5 provision of this act shall be punished by a fine not less
6 than three hundred dollars and by imprisonment not less
7 than three months nor more than six months.
