STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT, as Amended, Regarding Disposition of Motor Vehicle Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section thirty-three of chapter twenty-five of the revised
2 statutes as amended by section six of chapter two hundred
3 fifty-eight public laws nineteen hundred seventeen, section
4 four of chapter two hundred fifty-one public laws nineteen
5 hundred nineteen, section ninety-two of chapter two hun6 dred eleven, public laws nineteen hundred twenty-one, and
7 chapter one hundred twenty-two, public laws nineteen hun8 dred twenty-seven, is hereby amended by inserting the

9 words, 'an amount equivalent thereto' after the word "and" 10 in the third line thereof, so that said section as amended 11 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 92. All fees and moneys received by the secre-2 tary under the preceding sections shall be turned over to 3 the treasurer of state as provided in section twenty-six of 4 this act and an amount equivalent thereto shall be appro-5 priated and used for the administration of the office and 6 duties of the commission as provided by general law, in-7 cluding the expenses of administering the motor vehicle 8 department and the licensing of operators and registration 9 of vehicles, and for the repair and maintenance of state and 10 state aid highways under the direction of the commission 11 and to meet all provisions of the bond issues for highways 12 construction as heretofore provided by statute.'

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
