STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Raising Money for Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Towns having a valuation of less than three million dol-
2 lars may raise an amount not exceeding one mill on the
3 valuation of such towns as shown by the previous year's
4 record, and for such sum so raised the state shall appro-
5 priate twice the same amount; towns having a valuation of
6 three million dollars or more may raise an amount not ex-
7 ceeding one-half of one mill on the valuation of such
8 towns as shown by the previous year's record, and for such
9 sum so raised the state shall appropriate an equal amount;
10 in each case the joint amount so raised and appropriated

11 shall be used within such towns in the repair and main-
12 tenance of such state highways, state aid highways and
13 third class highways as may be designated by the munici-
14 pal officers thereof and expended under the supervision of
15 the state highway commissioner.
