RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Thomaston.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be
2 paid to the town of Thomaston, Knox county, the sum of
3 three thousand one hundred and fifty dollars or such lesser
4 sum as the supreme court shall award, to reimburse said
5 town for damages awarded to George H. Starret for dam-
6 ages caused by the raising of the grade of the state high-
7 way in front of his buildings at the eastern end of the Mill
8 river bridge in said town of Thomaston.
