STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Capturing of Bees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall enter upon the land of another for the 2 purpose of capturing, destroying or interfering with a 3 swarm of bees which is already established, or removing 4 honey from same, except by the consent of the owner of
