STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Require Voters in Municipal or Village Corporations to be Legal Residents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall have the right to vote in any municipal or

village corporation election or meeting for any purpose

whatsoever unless he shall be a legal resident and other
wise qualified according to law. All provisions to the con
trary in any municipal or village corporation charter are

hereby repealed.
