IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Making it Unlawful for Depositing Sawdust in the
Limits of the Highway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any owner, operator, manager or
2 employee of any mill used in the sawing of lumber to es-
3 tablish, locate or use the same within such proximity to
4 any way of the state as to allow the sawdust therefrom to
5 blow into such highway.
