STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Authorize the Town of South Bristol to Raise Money for the Purpose of Helping Keep in Repair the Cemeteries in Said Town.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The inhabitants of the town of South Bristol, a municipal
corporation in the county of Lincoln, are hereby authorized
to raise money, under an appropriate article in the town
warrant, to help keep in good repair and condition all monuments, headstones, markers and graves in any or all of
the cemeteries of said town and also to keep all bushes
and grass cut and the trees and shrubs properly trimmed.
