STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Register of Probate's
Office for Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That portion of section forty-five of chapter one hundred
2 and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended by chap-
3 ter two hundred and nineteen of the public laws of nine-
4 teen hundred and twenty-one, and as amended further, re-
5 lating to clerk hire in the county offices in Oxford county,
6 is hereby further amended by striking out the words "five
7 hundred and twenty dollars" in the fourth and fifth lines
8 of the sub-paragraph relating to Oxford county and insert-

9 ing in place thereof the words 'eight hundred,' so that said
10 sub-paragraph of said section as amended shall read as
11 follows:

'For clerks in the office of the register of deeds, eight hun-
2 dred dollars, and such additional amount as may be author-
3 ized by the county commissioners; for clerks in the office
4 of register of probate, eight hundred dollars; for clerks in
5 the office of clerk of courts, six hundred dollars.'
