STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Maine Institution for the Blind for Repairs to Buildings for the Year Nineteen Hundred Thirty.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for 2 the fiscal year from July first, nineteen hundred and 3 twenty-nine to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty 4 the sum of one thousand dollars for repairs to buildings.

MEMORANDUM

Prior to this time all repairs to buildings have been taken out of current funds. For the past three years it has been necessary to add a new boiler in the school building, entire new conduits and wiring for electric power and light, extensive repairs to sidewalks, and other general repairs. From estimates, the repairs to floors alone in the Barker Memorial Building will cost five hundred dollars. The repairs to the walls and ceiling to this building will cost an equal amount.
