STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Charter of the City of Saco.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter two hundred fifteen of the private
2 and special laws of the year one thousand, eight hundred
3 and sixty-seven is hereby amended by striking out the whole
4 of said section and substituting in place thereof the follow-
5 ing, viz:

'Sect. 5. Every law, act or ordinance, or bill appropri-
2 ating money, having passed the city council, shall be pre-
3 sented to the mayor, and if he approves the same, he shall
4 sign it, if not, he shall return it within seven days, with
5 his objections, to the city council, which shall enter the

6 objections at large on its records, and proceed to recon-
7 sider said law, act or ordinance, or bill appropriating money.
8 If, upon such reconsideration, two-thirds of the whole num-
9 ber of the members of the board of aldermen shall agree
10 to pass it, and so vote, it shall have the same effect as if
11 signed by the mayor, and it shall be the duty of the mayor
12 to sign any warrant necessary for the execution of such
13 law, act or ordinance, or bill appropriating money, and in
14 case of his refusal, the city council may order the treasurer
15 to pay any expense incurred by the passage of any bill
16 appropriating money, and their order shall be sufficient au-
17 thority and voucher for the treasurer to pay the same.'
