STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Amount Allowed for Clerk Hire in the Office of the Register of Deeds in Piscataquis County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen

of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amend
ded by striking out in the first and second lines of the twelfth

paragraph thereof the words "seven hundred and twenty
eight" and isserting in place thereof the words 'eight hun
dred eighty-four,' so that said paragraph as amended shall

read as follows:

'Piscataquis county, for clerks in the office of register of 2 deeds, eight hundred eighty-four dollars; for clerks in the 3 office of register of probate, two hundred dollars; for clerks4 in the office of clerks of courts, five hundred dollars.'
