STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Amount Allowed for Clerk Hire in the
Office of the Register of Deeds in Piscataquis County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen
2 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amend-
3 ed by striking out in the first and second lines of the twelfth
4 paragraph thereof the words "seven hundred and twenty-
5 eight" and inserting in place thereof the words 'eight hun-
6 dred eighty-four,' so that said paragraph as amended shall
7 read as follows:

'Piscataquis county, for clerks in the office of register of
2 deeds, eight hundred eighty-four dollars; for clerks in the

3 office of register of probate, two hundred dollars; for clerks
4 in the office of clerks of courts, five hundred dollars.'
