IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE

AN ACT to Regulate Water Flowage in North East Pond.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or
2 corporation, during the months of June, July and August
3 of each year to draw or cause to be drawn down, the
4 water in the North East pond, so-called, situated partly
5 in the town of Lebanon, in the county of York and state
6 of Maine, to a level below seven feet from high water
7 mark through any canal, sluiceway, runway, spillway or
8 artificial conduit.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall

2 for each offense pay a fine of not less than twenty nor
3 more than two hundred dollars and cost of prosecution
4 and in addition shall be punished by imprisonment for not
5 exceeding six months.
