STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, for the Purchase of One Hundred Copies of "Sketches of Brooks History."

Resolved: That the state purchase one hundred copies of 2 the book entitled "Sketches of Brooks History" written by 3 Seth W. Norwood, at five dollars per copy, said books to 4 be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the state 5 librarian; and that there be and hereby is appropriated for 6 this purpose the sum of five hundred dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

"Sketches of Brooks History" contains narrative in regard to the town, its religious history, the Bench and Bar, educational and medical histories, the town during the various wars from Colonial times, societies and clubs, agriculture and industries, etc., with brief biographies of all the early settlers, physicians, lawyers, postmasters, ministers, merchants, and those identified with the interest of the town. Subjects having special reference to the state have been included because they have been so related to the early history of the town as to have practically become a part of it. Biographies of the lives of the presidents and governors of Maine who were in office during the time of some special period in the history of Brooks have also been included. The index is divided as to subject, persons and illustrations.

The book will contain about two hundred seventy-five pages, printed on 70 pound white silkote and bound in full cloth T pattern, stamped in gold, and will be 6 by 9 inches in size when finished.
