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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Municipal Court  
Recorder of Sanford.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter thirty-nine of the private and  
2 special laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen, as amended,  
3 is hereby further amended, by striking out in the third line  
4 thereof the word "four" and inserting in place thereof  
5 the word 'six,' so that said section as amended shall read  
6 as follows:

'Sect. 2. The recorder of the Sanford municipal court  
2 shall receive as compensation an annual salary of six hun-  
3 dred dollars, payable quarterly, on the first days of Janu-

4 ary, April, July and October, from the county treasury of  
5 the county of York. All fees received by him shall be paid  
6 over to the county treasurer.'
