STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Prohibit Lobster Fishing in Certain Waters of Winter Harbor and Gouldsboro.

Pe it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

It shall be unlawful to set any trap or other device used 2 for the catching of lobsters, or to take and catch any lob-3 sters within the following described limits, during the 4 months of July and August of each year: from Jordan's 5 Island in the town of Gouldsboro to Egg Rock, thence east-6 erly in a straight line to the southern end of Turtle Island, 7 thence easterly in a straight line to the southern end of 8 Mark Island, thence in a due east course to the Schoodic 9 shore in the town of Winter Harbor.
