STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Trustees of the Bridge Between
East Machias and Machiasport.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of five thousand dollars (\$5000.00) for repairing the
3 bridge between East Machias and Machiasport across the
4 Machias river.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This bridge is a part of the highway connecting the towns of Machiasport and East Machias, and in addition to general use, it is used for the trucking of the canned products from the canning plants at Machiasport to the Machiasport railroad station, situated in the town of East Machias.

The bridge also crosses the tide waters of the Machias river and for that reason it is necessary to maintain a draw therein.

The draw to this bridge is now very badly out of repair and it is necessary to have the present draw taken out, a new piling foundation put therein, and the draw replaced. And in addition other necessary repairs by way of planking and railing.
