#### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Towns of Gardiner and Randolph.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to 2 be paid to the towns of Gardiner and Randolph, to aid in 3 the repair and maintenance of the drawbridge between the 4 two towns, the sum of one thousand dollars to be used for 5 the maintenance of said drawbridge and twenty-five hun-6 dred dollars to be used for painting same, for the fiscal 7 year nineteen hundred thirty and one thousand dollars to 8 be used for maintenance for the fiscal year nineteen hung dred thirty-one.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

This bridge is much used by the general public and the traffic is large. It is the connecting link between the Kennebec, Lincoln and Knox counties.
