STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Medway.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of one thousand dollars to aid in replanking the 3 bridge over the east branch of the Penobscot river in the 4 town of Medway, provided the town of Medway raises 5 five hundred dollars for the same purposes, the funds for 6 this bridge to be taken from the maintenance fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is a steel bridge over three hundred feet in length, located on the heavily traveled highway which serves as the only outlet for the towns of Millinocket and East Millinocket. It was built by a bridge district consisting of the towns of Millinocket, East Millinocket and Medway at a cost of about twenty-one thousand dollars. About one-third of this bridge was replanked in 1928 and the remainder is very much in need of replanking. Medway has a population of about 450 and a valuation of about \$448,000.
