STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Anna L. Gagan
of Lewiston.

Resolved: That a pension of fifteen dollars per month be,
2 and hereby is, granted to Anna L. Gagan, of Lewiston, to
3 be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers
4 and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin
5 July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine and continue
6 until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Anna L. Gagan is the widow of George G. Gagan, a Spanish War Veteran. Her husband died in 1919. She has two daughters living with her. She is in very poor health and probably will never be able to take care of herself. She receives a federal pension of \$30.00 per month, and is also receiving state aid under the general law, but the amounts which she is receiving are insufficient to the support of herself and family.
