STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Caratunk Plantation.

Resolved: That there be paid to Caratunk plantation the 2 sum of seven hundred and forty dollars to reimburse said 3 plantation for the purchase of part of the reserved lands 4 in said plantation occupied by Mary Spaulding. The above 5 amount shall be charged to the reserved land fund held 6 by the treasurer of state for said plantation. The state 7 auditor is hereby authorized to certify said payment, and 8 the treasurer of state is hereby authorized to make the 9 necessary adjustments on his records to comply with the 10 terms of this resolve.
