House Amendment "A" to H. P. 1620—Bill "An Act relating to County Jails."

Amend said bill by striking out beginning in the fourteenth
2 line thereof the words "and if said commissioners, after
3 such order, neglect or refuse to make such alteration, or to
4 provide for the classification of convicts and persons charged
5 with crime, the said board of commissioners may cause said
6 convicts and persons charged with crime to be removed
7 to any jail where such alteration or provision for classifica-
8 tion has been made, and the expense of the removal and
9 keeping of such convicts or persons shall be paid by the
10 county from which such convict or person is removed,"
